

PROCEED WITH CAUTION

Once installed, LOCK BLØK cannot be easily repositioned.

Before attempting to attach LOCK BLØK to the classroom door, we highly recommend that you do a trial placement to ensure it will work properly.

Carefully read and FOLLOW ALL INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS and warnings below.


Open Mode: rubber slide is moved to the edge of the door (Diagrams L-1 and R-1)

- ✓ The slide should prevent the door from closing completely.
- ✓ The latch hardware should not engage when the door is pulled closed.

Closed Mode: slide is moved away from the edge of the door (Diagrams L-2 and R-2)

- ✓ The door should close completely and the latch should engage.
- ✓ Verify that the door latches shut when LOCK BLØK is in Closed Mode.

1. Face the side of the door that comes in contact with the door frame. For most classrooms, this will be the inside surface of the door.
2. Open the door and secure it in an open position. Clean and dry the area of the door where you are going to attach LOCK BLØK. (Isopropyl alcohol is recommended.) METAL DOORS: LOCK BLØK will not bond well to a cold door.
3. Place the rubber slide in the plastic housing.
4. If the door latch hardware is on the LEFT side of the door, move the slide to the left. If the door latch hardware is on the RIGHT side of the door, move the slide to the right.



5. Remove the paper backing from the two adhesive strips attached to the back side of the plastic housing.
6. Without allowing the adhesive to come in contact with the door surface, align the edge of the rubber slide so that it is approximately an 1/8" away from the edge of the door.
7. Check to ensure that the plastic housing is level and then press it firmly against the door so that the adhesive forms a strong bond. *Suggestion:* For the best bond to occur, keep LOCK BLØK in Closed Mode for 24 hours.



WARNING: The door will not close completely and latch shut when LOCK BLØK is in Open Mode. If the door needs to be fully closed and latched, LOCK BLØK must be in Closed Mode.
